### **New to coaching?**

If you are just starting your coaching journey, you want to work with children, or in schools, but are do not yet have the valuable experience and guidance that other companies need you to have, or have yet to start your FA Level One coaching course, we are here to help.

Frontline Football are always looking for passionate, enthusiastic coaches, and with our Coaching Development Programme we offer those with a desire to coach the opportunity to make a start within the sports industry, and hopefully see us work together in the near future.

We therefore conduct our Frontline Coaching Development courses throughout the year, which gives you a chance to attend a day's training in which we look to develop your coaching skills, session planning, session delivery and interventions, and action planning, alongside guidance of how to get on to a FA Level One course, assistance throughout the duration of your Level One, and the opportunity to work with our players whilst completing the practical elements of the FA Course.

Our aim would therefore be for you to gain the necessary experience with Frontline Football to successfully complete your FA qualification, and have a job ready and waiting with us at the completion of your course.

### **Aged 15-18 Years old?**

Frontline Football is also passionate about involving 15-18 year olds from the local area in our afterschool, team, and school holiday coaching programmes. We therefore offer work-based experience roles for those young adults who have an incentive to start a football/multi-sports coaching role, those who wish to gain experience prior/during a college or university course, and to those who want to learn about working with young children and sportsman in a school or sports environment.

Focused on personal growth, a positive outlook and developing individual communication skills, responsibility, confidence to deliver practices, and learning how to design effective practices, our work experience roles are a fantastic opportunity to make the best start in a thriving industry.

We also aim to offer young people the necessary advice, should they be interested in sport, to ensure every student can develop the required skills, and show the desire to want to progress and





succeed in achieving their goals, becoming both positive role models for the children they work with, but also their friends and peers.

### **Frontline Coaching Development courses:**

These courses are designed to be an exciting opportunity for you to take your first steps into coaching, and to having a positive impact on young children's sporting lives.

Over the course of a day's training, you will be encouraged to develop your:

- Planning and designing age-appropriate sessions
- Delivering your sessions effectively
- Intervention techniques
- Roles and responsibilities of a sports coach
- Communication, listening and interaction skills
- Reviewing and Action Planning
- Football and Multi-Sports based sessions
- How to inspire fair play, and deal successfully with issues that arise
- How to create a fun, learning and safe environment for your players.

In addition, we will also offer the following:

- Guidance on applying for, and attending, your FA Level One, or other FA courses
- Support throughout the duration of your FA course
- The chance to practice and deliver the practical course elements with Frontline Football players
- Information on Frontline Football, and how you can play a positive role in the development of the club and its players.

### **Work-Based Experience Programme:**

Our work experience placements are designed to offer individuals and schools/organisations the opportunity to work in partnership with Frontline Football, and give young, enthusiastic adults the chance to gain valuable experience and knowledge about the coaching industry.





We aim to develop an individual's social and psychological skills, by focusing on the following:

- Building self-confidence through interaction with workmates and children
- Improved communication skills
- Working as a team, and tasked with individual challenges within sessions
- Ensuring actions that portray themselves as a positive role model to colleagues and children taking part in the sports session
- The importance of reliability, punctuality and appearance
- Showing independence, initiative and motivation on session
- Displaying a positive attitude towards physical activity.

For those who start with, and those who develop, the extra desire and incentive to work towards a career in the sports, football or multi-sports industry (Football Coach, PE Teacher etc), all F.C.D placements offer the following:

- Training and vital experience in a working environment
- Learning the roles and responsibilities of a coach
- Knowledge and understanding of rules, regulations and techniques of several sports
- Detailed information and methods on session planning
- Planning sessions with an understanding of how to make them age and topic appropriate
- Experience at delivering practices
- How use of positive language can assist with, and help to create, a fun, learning environment
- Guidance on how to become FA qualified, or qualified in other sports
- How to set up events for young children, where they can take part in sports and activities in primary schools, and other possible sporting environments.
